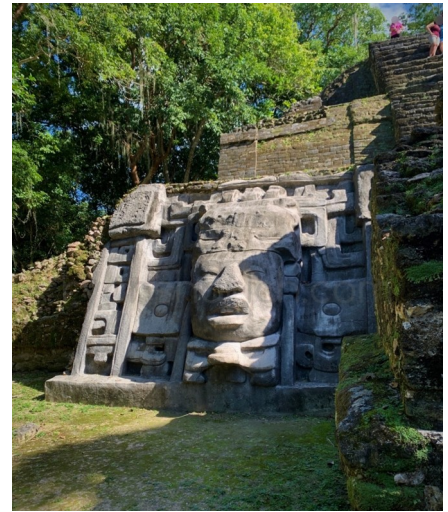

After all of Jay's Group... " *Capice!* ", had taken photos and climbed up/down the stairs, we were to now head back the way we came in.



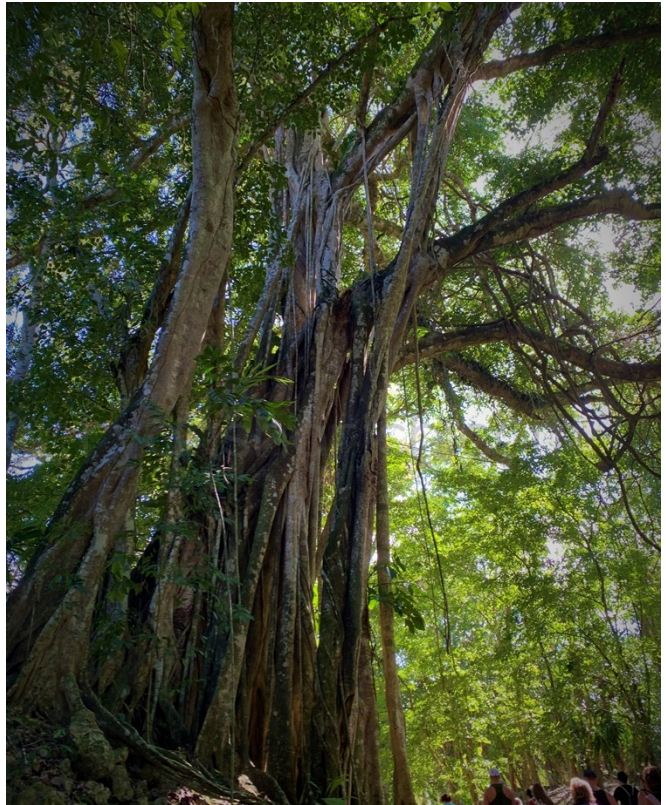

We would be heading to the upper portion of the building on the right to eat.





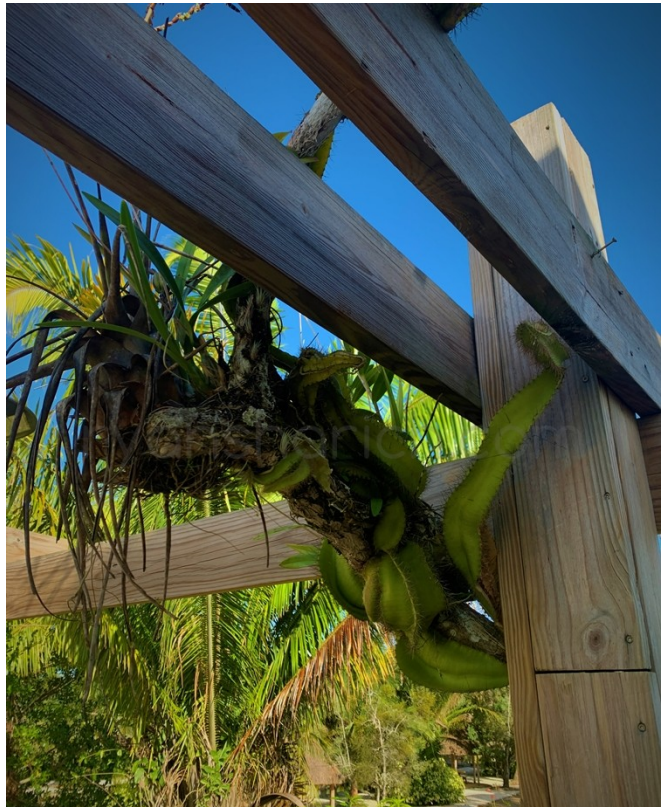

Plantains

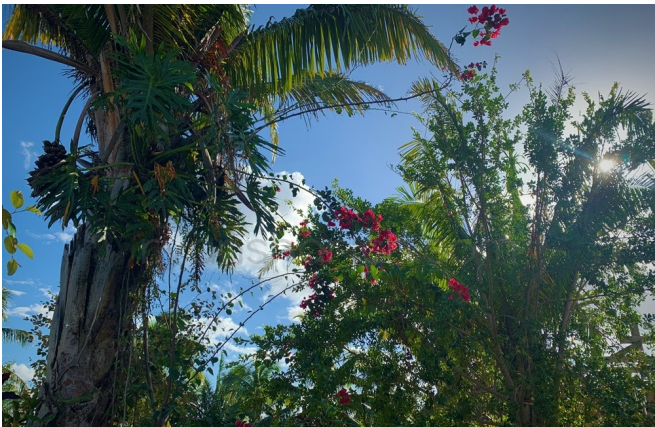
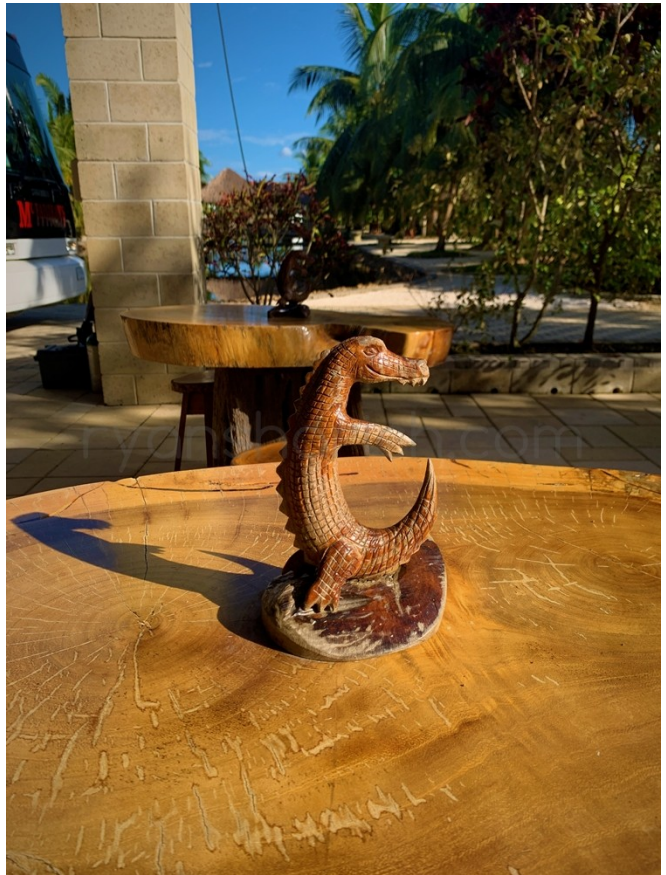

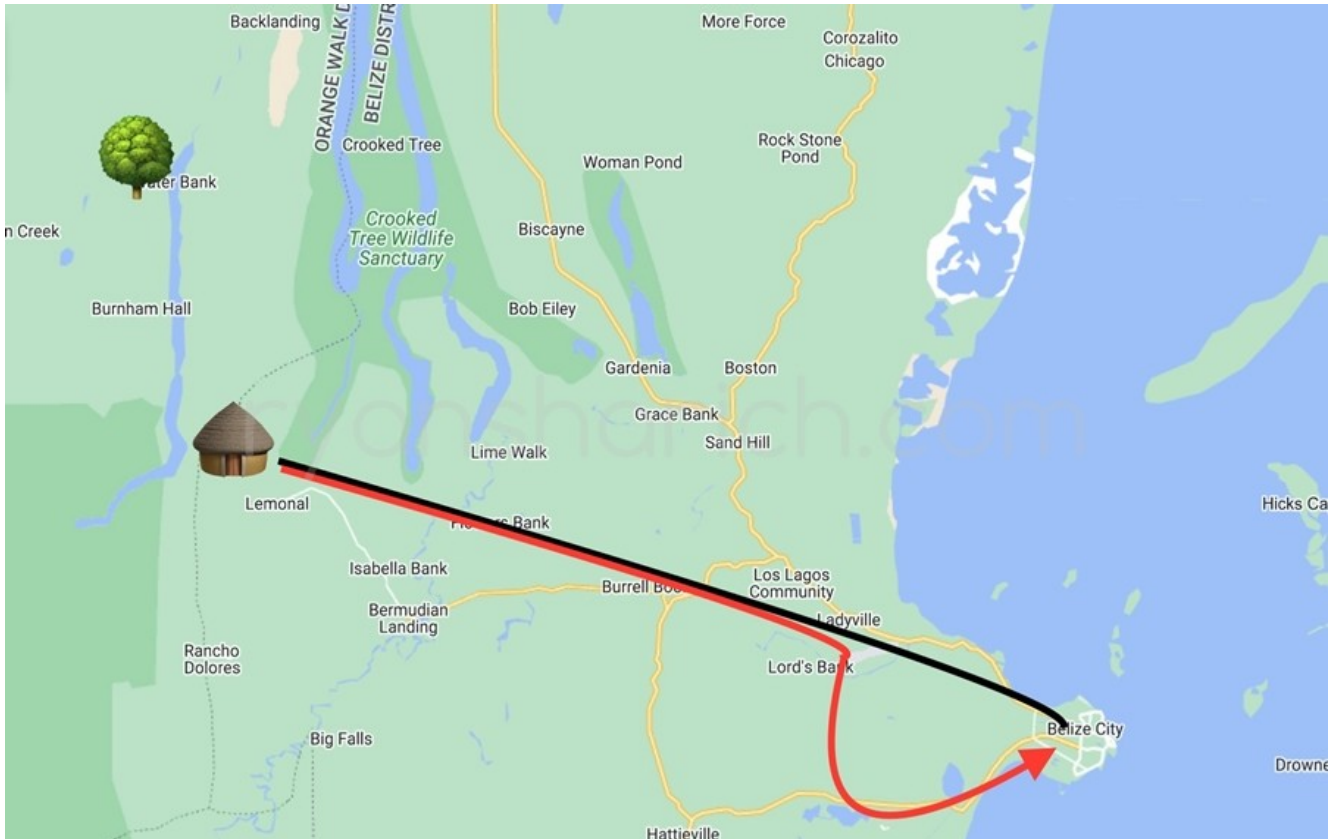


The blue halo effect is because of the sunshade film over the bus windows.

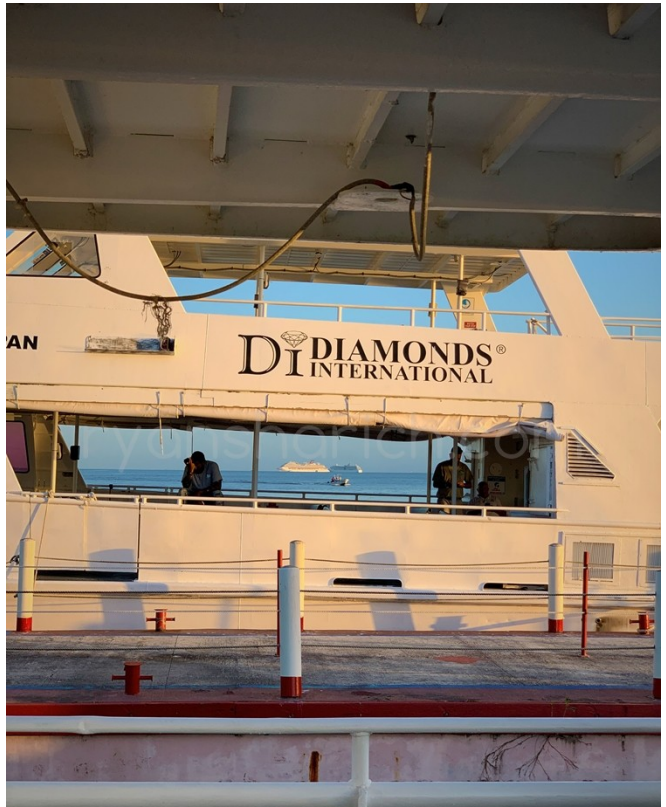


The Belize flag (backwards) walking back in.

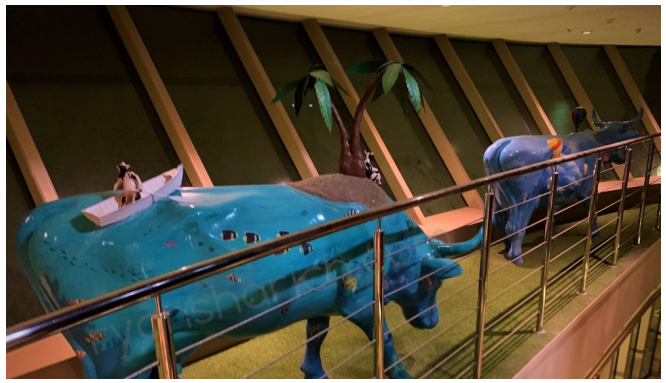

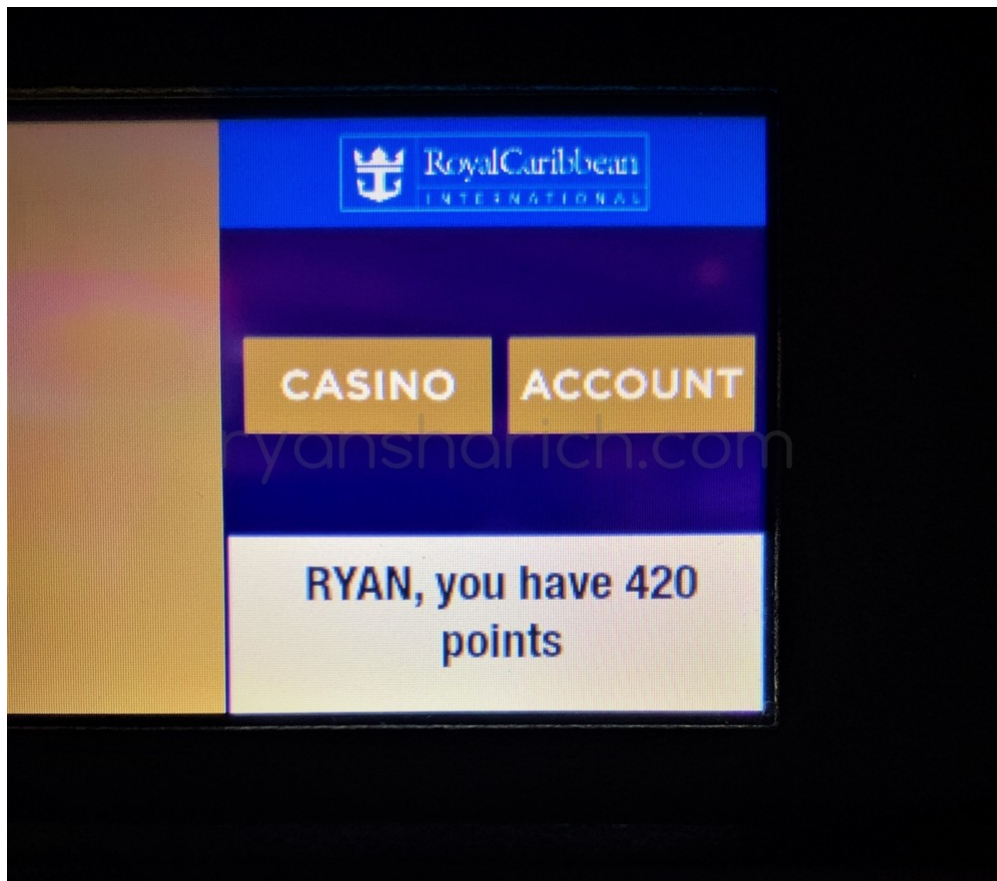


It was alright... the Toto cake
